

Thanks to all participants, volunteers, sponsors, and the Castle Rock Downtown Merchants Association for making the 11th Annual Classic Rock Car Show a huge success. With a sold out car show of 320 vehicles registered, the Vintage Car Club awarded 52 trophies in 23 categories that included a long distance traveled award and our traditional awards such as Castle Rock's Mayor Choice, Hottest Car (picked by the Fire Chief), Most Likely to Get Pulled Over (picked by the Police Chief), and Best of Show.

The Vintage Car Club selects and recognizes the top vehicles by class as equal winners. Therefore, there are no first, second and third place winners by class. Also, the number of trophies awarded for each class is determined annually based on the average number of cars per class that have registered for the car show over the past 5 years.
